<p>High Level Scope: This project located in the Mid-City community in San Diego and proposes to replace existing CMP storm drain with approximately 250 feet of new Reinforced Concrete Pipe, replace three outfalls, and abandon 50 feet of existing storm drain. The replace-in-place will consist of open trench methods. Project will also include Green Infrastructure (GI) improvements. Approximately 4,026 square feet of biofiltration systems, one Filterra planter box, and two modified catch basins will be installed to treat an 11-acre drainage area for the 0.5-inch rain event. Design of the project was previously started under as-needed contract, and was put on hold at the 60% design. The new contract will complete the design and provide bid and construction support.</p>
